



STDs in Northwest Georgia

- The most common reportable illnesses we see in the ten-county Northwest Georgia Public Health district are STDs -- Sexually Transmitted Diseases. Chlamydia and gonorrhea are the top two.
- We received over 1,300 reports of chlamydia and over 330 reports of gonorrhea in 2014. Over half of these infections were in persons aged 15-24 years old.
- Statewide, there were over 46,000 cases of chlamydia and almost 13,000 cases of gonorrhea in 2013, with well over half these infections in persons aged 15-24 years old.
- Many people do not have any symptoms when they are infected with an STD.
